LOOKING TO MAKE MORE ZINES?

HOW TO MAKE A THREE-FOLD, ONE-CUT BOOK:

STEP 1:

Fold paper in half the long ways and unfold.

STEP 2:


Fold in half the short way. Unfold and fold each short edge to the middle fold. Unfold and there will be eight squares.

STEP 3:

Cut along the long ways fold between the middle two squares.

STEP 4:

To make the book, fold long ways, then gently push ends together, allowing the middle (where cut) to spring apart. Then fold together to form the book.



NOTE:

This structure has all of its pages on one side of the sheet of paper, which makes it very easy for printing or photocopying.
